**PROVISIONAL SUSPENSION ORDER AND
MINUTE OF TELEPHONE CONFERENCE
DATED 17 July 2019**

1. Jason Anderson is a powerlifter, and his sport has adopted the 2019 Sports Anti-Doping Rules (SADR) promulgated by Drug Free Sport New Zealand (DFSNZ) as its anti-doping policy.
2. On 10 July 2019, DFSNZ filed an Application for the Provisional Suspension of Mr Anderson. On 12 July 2019, DFSNZ confirmed service on Mr Anderson.
3. A telephone conference was convened by the Tribunal Chairman on 17 July 2019 in respect of the Provisional Suspension Application. Mr Anderson advised that he did not oppose the application and waived his right to request a "B" sample analysis.
4. Accordingly, and being satisfied that there was no substantive reason why provisional suspension should not be imposed, the Tribunal Chairman ordered the provisional suspension of Mr Anderson with immediate effect from 17 July 2019. Mr Anderson may not take part in any way in any event or activity, organised, sanctioned or authorised by the New Zealand Powerlifting Federation or by any other sporting organisation which is a signatory to the SADR.
5. The following timetabling orders were made in relation to the substantive anti-doping rule violation proceedings:
 - (a) DFSNZ is to file and serve its Form 1 and any written material in support by Wednesday 31 July 2019;
 - (b) the Respondent is to file and serve his Form 2 together with any evidence and other written material in support by Wednesday 14 August 2019; and
 - (c) A further teleconference is set for 9am Friday 16 August 2019.
6. A copy of this Provisional Suspension Order and Minute will be sent to the parties but otherwise should remain confidential until publication of the final decision on the Anti-Doping Rule Violations. All other process steps under the SADR should similarly remain confidential.
