**PROVISIONAL SUSPENSION ORDER AND  
MINUTE OF TELEPHONE CONFERENCE  
DATED 24 MAY 2018**

1. Harrisyn Jones was a member of New Zealand Cricket at the time of the alleged breaches. New Zealand Cricket has adopted the Sports Anti-Doping Rules (SADR) promulgated by Drug Free Sport New Zealand (DFSNZ) as its anti-doping policy.
2. On 17 May 2018, DFSNZ filed an Application for the Provisional Suspension of Mr Jones alleging breaches of 2015 SADR 2.6 and 2.2.
3. A telephone conference was convened by the Tribunal Chairman on 24 May 2018 in respect of the Provisional Suspension Application. Mr Jones advised that he did not oppose the provisional suspension application.
4. Accordingly, and being satisfied that there was no substantive reason why provisional suspension should not be imposed, the Tribunal Chairman ordered the provisional suspension of Mr Jones with immediate effect from 24 May 2018. Mr Jones may not take part in any way in any event or activity, organised, sanctioned or authorised by New Zealand Cricket or by any other sporting organisation which is a signatory to the SADR.
5. The following timetabling orders were made in relation to the substantive anti-doping rule violation proceedings:
  - (a) DFSNZ is to file and serve any written material in support of its Form 1 by 1 June 2018;
  - (b) the Respondent is to file and serve his Form 2 together with any evidence and other written material in support by 21 June 2018; and
  - (c) DFSNZ is to file and serve any written material in response by 4 July 2018.
6. A copy of this Provisional Suspension Order and Minute will be sent to the parties but otherwise should remain confidential until publication of the final decision on the Anti-Doping Rule Violations. All other process steps under the SADR should similarly remain confidential.

7. Mr Jones was anxious to see if this matter could proceed more quickly. If the parties are able to reach an agreement, a proposal may be submitted to the Tribunal at any time.
