

**DECISION OF TRIBUNAL ON APPLICATION
FOR PROVISIONAL SUSPENSION**

Application and disposition

1. The applicant Athletics New Zealand ("ANZ") applies under Rule 12.8 of the Sports Anti-Doping Rules (SADR) 2010 ("the Rules") for provisional suspension of Anna Bramley.
2. Ms Bramley was tested in competition on 26 March 2011 in Dunedin and a Report of Analysis indicates an adverse analytical finding for the presence of Canrenone which is a Prohibited Substance, as a metabolite of Spirolactone.
3. Ms Bramley did not contest the application for provisional suspension and a formal order is made (below).


Effect of provisional suspension

4. Provisional suspension prohibits participation in any event or activity authorised by ANZ. It applies to other sports as a result of a 2010 amendment to SADR 12.9.
5. Provisional suspension remains confidential until publication of the final decision on the alleged Anti-Doping Rule violation, unless the Tribunal orders otherwise.

Order

6. Anna Bramley is provisionally suspended under the provisions of SADR 12 from 5 May 2011.
