# DECISION OF TRIBUNAL ON APPLICATION FOR PROVISIONAL SUSPENSION

#### **Application**

- Triathlon New Zealand Inc applies under Rule 12.1 of the Sports Anti-Doping Rules 2011 ("the Rules") for provisional suspension of Graham O'Grady.
- 2. Graham O'Grady was tested in-competition on 8 January 2011. A Certificate of Analysis reports an adverse analytical finding for the presence of the prohibited substance morphine.
- 3. Mr O'Grady has exercised his right to have the B sample analysed and the results of that are expected early next week.
- 4. Mr O'Grady opposes the application for provisional suspension and seeks to have the Tribunal defer its decision on the provisional suspension application until the results of the B sample are known next week.

#### Decision

- 5. The Tribunal has now considered the matter and has determined that it will issue its decision on the provisional suspension application today. The Tribunal has decided that Mr O'Grady shall be provisionally suspended from today's date.
- 6. Reasons for this decision will be issued next week.

#### Order

7. Graham O'Grady is provisionally suspended under Rule 12 of the Rules with immediate effect from the date of this Decision.
