- Basketball New Zealand (Basketball) has applied, under the provisions of the Sports Anti-Doping Rules 2011 (the Rules), for the provisional suspension of Daniel Ryan.
- Daniel Ryan was tested in competition at the TSB Arena, Wellington on 15 July 2011. His "A" sample returned an adverse analytical finding for the prohibited substances D-Amphetamine and D-Methamphetamine.
- 3. Basketball has adopted the Rules and under Rule 12.8 this Tribunal is obliged to promptly impose a provisional suspension where the adverse analytical finding is other than for a Specified Substance.
- 4. D-Amphetamine and D-Methamphetamine are not Specified Substances.
- 5. Daniel Ryan is therefore provisionally suspended as from the date of this Order. The existence of the Order is to remain confidential until publication of the final decision.
- 6. Under Rule 12.9 of the Rules, Daniel Ryan "may not take part in any way in any event or activity, organised, sanctioned or authorised by Basketball or any member organisation or club of Basketball or by any person in any way connected with Basketball".
- 7. The provisions of Rule 14.10.1 are deemed to apply which will prevent Daniel participating in any capacity in any competition, event or activity whether local or national organised, authorised or sanctioned by, any signatory member of the Rules or a club or other member organisation of a signatory member.
