- Mr Manson was tested in competition by Drug Free Sport on 28 February 2009. On 24 March 2009, the applicant was notified of an adverse analytical finding as the test showed a positive result for cannabis. The applicant in accordance with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules (2009) applied for provisional suspension.
- 2. The hearing took place by telephone conference on 30 March 2009.
- 3. Mr Manson has accepted the A sample result and will not be having the B sample tested. He did not make any submissions opposing provisional suspension. He was planning to play in the off season in Denmark but these plans are now on hold because of the positive test.
- The Tribunal does not see any reason not to provisionally suspend Mr Manson. He is therefore provisionally suspended as from today's date.
- 5. The Tribunal will expedite the substantive hearing when Drug Free Sport brings the application. It is asked to do so without delay. Mr Manson will be entitled to have a reduced sanction considered if he can establish to the satisfaction of the Tribunal how the cannabis entered his body and that it was not intended to enhance his sports performance.
