Introduction

Steven Robinson was the subject of a provisional suspension dated 24 April 2008 on the application of Basketball New Zealand for an Anti-Doping Rule Violation involving cannabis.

Decision

At a hearing convened on Tuesday 20th May 2008, Mr Robinson admitted the violation, and the Tribunal records its decision that the athlete is suspended from all participation in basketball, with Cross-Code effect, up to and including Sunday 1 June 2008. This Decision brings to account the effect of the provisional suspension to date, and for reasons which will be developed in the full Decision, has the overall effect of a six week suspension.
