Sports Tribunal suspends Otago Nuggets basketball player for cannabis violation

The Sports Tribunal has suspended Otago Nuggets NBL basketball player, Steven Robinson, from participating in sport because of an anti-doping violation relating to cannabis.

Upon receiving an application for provisional suspension from Basketball New Zealand, the Sports Tribunal imposed a provisional suspension on Mr Robinson on 24 April 2008.

The Sports Tribunal has heard the matter. Mr Robinson admitted the violation.

The Tribunal advises its decision that Mr Robinson is suspended from participating in sport up to and including 1 June 2008.

The Tribunal has taken the provisional suspension into account in reaching its decision and the overall effect is of a six week suspension.

Full reasons for the decision will follow in due course and will be made publicly available.
