PROVISIONAL SUSPENSION ORDER 30 July 2025

1. Shannon Drake is a New Zealand boxer and athlete who is registered with Boxing NZ.

Boxing NZ has adopted the 2025 Sports Anti-Doping Rules (SADR) promulgated by

the Sport Integrity Commission (Commission) as its anti-doping policy.

2. A sample was collected from Mr Drake on 1 June 2025 at the South Island Golden

Gloves event in Blenheim on that same date. The Commission alleges that, on

analysis, the sample was found to contain the presence of Cannabinoids/Carboxy-THC

(Cannabis) which is a specified substance prohibited in competition under class S8

Cannabinoids of the 2025 Prohibited List.

3. On 25 July 2025, the Commission filed an application for provisional suspension

alleging breaches of 2025 SADR 2.1 (Presence of a Prohibited Substance or its

Metabolites or Markers in an Athlete's Sample) and SADR 2.2 (Use or Attempted Use

by an Athlete of a Prohibited Substance or Prohibited Method).

4. On 30 July 2025, Mr Hunt, counsel for the Respondent, confirmed by email that Mr

Drake did not oppose the application for provisional suspension.

5. Accordingly, the Tribunal Chair is satisfied that there is no need for a hearing on

provisional suspension and no substantive reason why provisional suspension should

not be imposed.

Orders

6. The Tribunal orders that provisional suspension of Mr Drake will have effect from 30

July 2025, prohibiting his participation of any kind in any event or activity organised,

sanctioned or authorised by Boxing NZ or any other sporting organisation that is a

signatory to the SADR.

A copy of this Provisional Suspension Order (PSO) will be sent to the parties but

otherwise will remain confidential until publication of the final decision on the alleged

Anti-Doping Rule Violations. All other process steps under the SADR should similarly

remain confidential.
